3. Qualifications of Applicant

3.1 Applicant must achieve qualifications as required by individual programme

3.2 Applicant must hold a degree from the higher education institution accredited by Thailand's Office of the Higher Education Commission.

3.3 Applicant must submit a minimum English proficiency score for admission on one of following tests:

Important Notes:

- Higher criteria of English proficiency score for admission may be set by some programmes.
- TOEFL-ITP must be arranged by the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University only.
- English proficiency test must be taken within 2 years up to the application date

4. Required Documents

Applicant must upload a scanned copy of following documents (PDF format) through the online admission system:

- 4.1 English Proficiency Score Certificate
- 4.2 Degree Certificate
- 4.3 Academic Transcript
- 4.4 Photo (jpeg format)
- 4.5 Passport
- 4.6 Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 4.7 Health Certificate
- 4.8 Recommendation Letters (at least 2 referees)
- 4.9 Additional documents as required by individual programme (such as letter of work experience, professional license, publications, research proposal, etc.)

Important Notes:

- Applicant must submit all required documents for each programme of application.
- All document must be in English (with official translation).
- Submission of fraudulent document is prohibited. The Faculty of Graduate Studies shall proceed with legal action including termination of admission or student status. In this case, application and tuition fees are not refundable.

5. Application Process

The application is available via online. Applicant must complete following process as follows:

- 5.1 The online application is available at <http://www.grad.mahidol.ac.th>
- 5.2 Check qualifications and requirements as required by individual programme.
- 5.3 Create personal account for accessing the online admission system
- 5.4 Completely fill-in the online application form.
- 5.5 Document Uploading:
 - 5.5.1 Prepare all required documents with certifying of true copy.
 - 5.5.2 Each documents must be a scanned copy in PDF format (maximum size 2MB). Only a photo must be in jpg format.
- 5.6 Application fee is 500 Baht (non-refundable) for each programme of application.
The payment is available via following methods:
 - 5.6.1 Credit Card
 - 5.6.2 Invoice (pay at a bank located in Thailand)
 - 5.6.3 Bank Transfer-Swift Code (pay at a bank located outside Thailand)

Important Notes:

- Application fee is compulsory (non-refundable)
- Applicant must responsible to pay any additional fees as required by the bank (e.g. bank surcharge, transfer fee, currency exchange fee, etc.) in order to ensure that the equivalent of application fee 500.00 Baht will be transferred to the university's account.
- Applicant must pay attention to the payment since incorrect or mistaken payment will not be refundable.
- Applicant must complete the online application and payment within the application due date, otherwise his/her application will not be eligible for further admission process.

6. Consideration Process

The consideration process will be arranged by individual programme committee. A combination of considerations may be conducted to evaluate applicant's eligibility such as test, written examination, interview examination, publications, and topic of interest, etc.
