1. Hold a Master degree in Public Health or Master of Science (Public Health) or related Master degree in which are accepted from the Office of Higher Education
2. Have a minimum grade point average of 3.50
3. Have at least one year of working experience in public health or other related field after finishing the Master degree program
4. Have a TOEFL ITP score of at least 500, TOEFL Internet-based score of 61 or IELTS score of 5.

Exceptions from the above conditions may be granted by the Programme Committee and the Dean of Faculty of Graduate Studies;

5. Two copies of Passport
6. Two copies of English certificate (TOEFL/ IELTS/ MU-Grad Test)

(For Doctoral Program)

- TOEFL ITP score of at least 500, TOEFL Internet-based score of 61, or IELTS score of 5

(For Master's Program)

- TOEFL ITP score of at least 480, TOEFL Internet-based score of 54, IELTS score of 5 or MU GRAD TEST score of 60.

Notes

- Only accept TOEFL ITP score from examination center arranged by Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University.
 - TOEFL ITP taken from other domestic and overseas institutes are invalid.
 - The test date must be within previous 2 years before application date
 - Applicant who obtained a valid English score must submit an **official score certificate** along with your application. Otherwise, your English score will not be considered.

Doctor of Public Health

Research Proposal: Write research proposal in the area of interest. This proposal may be a potential dissertation proposal for the doctoral program. The areas of interest should be congruent with the Department specially areas which the applicants can retrieve from the application manual.

The proposal includes:

1. Title (or cover) Page
2. Abstract of the proposal
3. Table of content
4. Introduction (Background & Significance)
5. Statement of the problem/ Research question
6. Objective of the research, and/or Hypothesis
7. Expected benefit from this proposal
8. Review literature (including conceptual framework)
9. Research Method
10. References

The proposal should not exceed 5 pages in English. The proposal must be submitted with the application to the Secretary of the Public Health Doctoral Program no later than **(First Round) December 4, 2015** and **(Second Round) February 12, 2016**

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
