Announcement The Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University Subject: Schedule of 2nd English Proficiency Examination, Academic Year 2011/2012

The Faculty of Graduate Studies requires graduate students who have not passed the English Proficiency Examination to meet the standards of the Faculty of Graduate Studies by either taking the English courses or passing the English Proficiency Examination, in order to be qualified for graduation.

The Second English Proficiency Examination schedule, in the academic year 2011/2012, for graduate students and the public is as follows:

Applicant qualifications

Applicants must be a graduate student of Mahidol University who has not passed the English examination, or members of the public.

Application day

Monday, September 12, 2011 – Friday, September 23, 2011 At Time : 08.30 a.m. – 12.00 p.m. and 13.00 – 16.30 p.m.

(Except Weekends and Public Holidays)

Examination date and time

Saturday, October 8, 2011 : 9.00 a.m. - 12.00 p.m.

Announcement day

Friday, October 28, 2011



Application documents

- 1. Two 1-inch recent photos
- 2. 1 copy student card or 1 copy identification card and sign the copy with blue ink

Application fee

- 1. Master's degree, Graduate Diploma, Higher Graduate Diploma students and public pay 200 baht.
- 2. Doctoral degree
 - 2.1 Doctoral level students must take the TOEFL-ITP test and pay 1,000 baht.
 - 2.2 Those who apply to study a Doctoral degree pay 1,000 baht.

Application location

There are four branch offices of the Faculty of Graduate Studies. Applicants can apply at one of the following offices.

- Branch office of Salaya Campus : (Cashier) 3rd floor, Graduate Studies Building
- 2. Branch office at the Faculty of Science : 1st floor, Research Building
- Branch office at Faculty of Dentistry: 2nd floor, Learning and Recreation Building
- Branch office at Siriraj Hospital: 3rd floor: Environment Conservation Building

Examination location

The location of the examination will be **announced on** Wednesday, September 5, 2011 on the Faculty of Graduate Studies' website: www.grad.mahidol.ac.th. <u>Students should check the examination</u> <u>location by themselves.</u>



Examination regulations

The applicants must:

- <u>Not</u> bring any bags, communication devices, or valuables to the room, <u>except</u> the test registration form and the student card or identification card.
- 2. <u>Not</u> record or take a photo of the exam by using any cameras, tape recorders, or communication devices..
- 3. The test book and the answer sheet <u>must not</u> be taken from the testing room.
- 4. Use at least a 2B pencil to do an examination.
- 5. Be on time. Those who are more than 30 minutes late will not be allowed to take the examination under any circumstances (Please note that those who take an exam for a Doctoral degree **MUST** be on time).
- 6. Dress politely. The applicants should wear warm clothes because the room is air-conditioned. Moreover, the applicants must not wear sandals or flip-flops.
- 7. Not take the test registration form on the desk out of the testing room.

If the students do not follow the above regulations, their answer sheet will not be checked and they are not allowed to re-take the test within 1 year since the test date.
