Admission Requirements

1. A candidate must have one of the two following main requirements :
 - 1.1 Candidates must hold a Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 1st class honor or,
 - 1.2 Candidates must hold a Master's degree in any discipline with grade point average of 3.50
2. submit 3 copies evidence of scholarly or professional attainments and show satisfactory research preparation to the Programme Committee;
3. have a TOEFL score of at least 500, TOEFL computer-based score of 173, TOEFL Internet-based score of 61, or IELTS score of 5.

Those who do not have any of the test scores specified above will have to take the English Proficiency Examination of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on the specified examination day.

4. In case your qualification does not match to the admission criteria, candidates must prior attach A "Requesting Form for Examination" approved by the program director. The form must be submitted before making the application. Kindly download here:

Exceptions from the above conditions may be granted by the Programme Committee and the Dean of Faculty of Graduate Studies;

Registration

1. Students must register as full-time students.
2. The Programme Committee may recommend students take up to 9 credits of course-work in any subject offered by the Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies or other departments in Mahidol University without credit and the student has to attend at least 80% of the classes.
3. The Programme Committee will require students to present at least one paper per year in an academic conference or a public forum on an aspect of their research.
4. At the end of each academic semester students will provide a detailed report to the Supervisory Panel on the progress made during that semester, the progress expected to be made in the

upcoming year, and details of any problems associated with the research which have arisen or may arise. After reviewing the student progress, the Supervisory Panel will forward the report, with their own comments, to the Programme Committee which will confirm, suspend, or terminate the student's enrollment.

Prepare the following required documents to submit via online admission system or post :

- A letter certifying that an applicant is currently in the final year prior to graduation 2 copies
(for an applicant seeking for a degree)
- A detailed transcript of a degree (for an applicant with a degree completion) 2 copies
- A grade report with course names and grades received from the first to the current 2 copies

- A copy of identification card 2 copies
- A copy of house registration certification 2 copies
- A copy of Certificate of English score: TOEFL/ IELTS/ MU-Test (if any). 2 copies
