A candidate must:

Plan A A(1)

1. hold a Bachelor's degree in the field of Public Health from a domestic or oversea institution approved by the Ministry of Education
2. have a minimum grade point average of 2.50
3. have at least 3 years of professional experience in the field of Public Health until the enrollment date and have at least 1 international publication.
4. submit a research/ thesis proposal
5. Submit one reference.
6. Include Curriculum-Vitae.
7. Have a TOEFL score of at least 480, TOEFL computer-based score of 157, TOEFL Internet-based score of 54, or IELTS score of 5 or pass the English Proficiency Examination arranged by the Faculty of Graduate Studies. Those who do not have any of the test scores specified above will have to take the English Proficiency Examination of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on the specified examination day.

Exemption from the above conditions may be granted by the Programme Committee under exceptional circumstances.

Plan A A(2)

1. hold a Bachelor's degree in the field of Public Health from a domestic or oversea institution approved by the Ministry of Education
2. have a minimum grade point average of 2.50
3. have at least 2 years of professional experience in the field of Public Health until the enrollment date.
4. Submit one reference.
5. Include Curriculum-Vitae.
6. Have a TOEFL score of at least 480, TOEFL computer-based score of 157, TOEFL Internet-based score of 54, or IELTS score of 5 or pass the English Proficiency Examination arranged by the Faculty of Graduate Studies. Those who do not have any of the test scores specified above will have to take the English Proficiency Examination of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on the specified examination day.

Exemption from the above conditions may be granted by the Programme Committee under exceptional circumstances.

Admission criteria

1. Interview in English
2. Pass the Comprehensive Examination (Required Courses)
3. TOEFL is not less than 500 and or IELTS is not less than the 5 within 2 years from the application date. Or English test scores from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University (Open six times examination test per year).

Applicant qualification : Type A (Plan A 1)

1. Graduate with degree in medicine and public health or related field.
2. At least 3 years work experience.
3. A draft of the dissertation proposal (approximately)

Applicant qualification : Type A (Plan A 2)

1. Interview in English
2. Pass the Comprehensive Examination (Required Courses)
3. TOEFL is not less than 500 and or IELTS is not less than the 5 within 2 years from the application date. Or English test scores from the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University (Open six times examination test per year).

Additional advantages of the programme

Program emphasizes the development of managerial and leadership skills for medical and paramedical public health care professionals from all over the world, especially Asia. PHC development is recognized as an appropriate channel for public health service in the improvement of existing human resources, making use of appropriate technology, and encouraging community participation. Since 1986, AIHD has produced 633 graduates from 34 countries, currently working as PHC leaders with the common goals of efficient and effective health services and improvement in the quality of life.

For curriculum revision. The curriculum is divided into two types of studies, firstly study plan focus on research-based and research courses work designed to be flexible according to the students' characteristic, such as study like a module which can be completed within 2 - 3 weeks.

Selection Procedure

The admission result will be made by considering from application documents and English Proficiency score.

Additional information for applicants

To qualify for graduate, the participants must complete all course work and thesis. For the MPH degree, students must take no less than 36 credit hours and a GPA at least 3.00 are required.

5. Or any other health related field.

- Two (2) recent photographs (1x1 inch in size)
- A copy of an applicant's degree certificate or a letter of graduation certification (for an applicant with a degree completion) 2 copies
- A letter certifying that an applicant is currently in the final year prior to graduation (for an applicant seeking for a degree) 2 copies
- A detailed transcript of a degree (for an applicant with a degree completion) 2 copies
- A grade report with course names and grades received from the first to the current semester prior to graduation 2 copies
- A copy of identification card 2 copies
- A copy of house registration certification 2 copies
- A copy of Certificate of English score: TOEFL/IELTS/MU-Test (if any). See detail here: 2 copies
