## **Admission Requirements**

### candidates must:

- 1. Have a Bachelor degrees in Health Sciences, eg, Pharmacy, Medicine, and Dentistry.
- 2. Have a minimum grade point average of 2.50;
- 3. If GPA is lower than 2.50, the applicant should have experiences in drug-related management in either public or private sectors, or have publication (s) related to drug system
- 4. Capable of English communication, ie. reading, speaking and writing;
- 5. Have a TOEFL score of at least 480, TOEFL computer-based score of 157, TOEFL Internet-based score of 54, or IELTS score of 4.5 or pass the English Proficiency Examination arranged by the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

Those who do not have any of the test scores specified above will have to take the English Proficiency Examination of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on the specified examination day.

Exemption from the above conditions may be granted by the Programme Committee under exceptional circumstances.
