candidates must:

- 1. Have a Bachelor's degrees in Health Sciences, eg, Pharmacy, Medicine, and Dentistry, with a minimum GPA of 3.25;
- 2. Have a Master's degrees in Health Sciences, eg, Pharmacy, Medicine, Dentistry and Nursing, with a minimum GPA of 3.50;
- 3. If GPA is lower than required above in 1 and 2, the applicant should have experiences in drugrelated management in either public or private sectors, or have publication (s) related to drug system,
- 4. Capable of English communication, ie. reading, speaking and writing;
- 5. Have a TOEFL score of at least 500, TOEFL computer-based score of 173, TOEFL Internet-based score of 61, or IELTS score of 5.

Those who do not have any of the test score specified above will have to take the English Proficiency Examination of the Faculty of Graduate Studies on the specified examination day.

Exemption from the above conditions may be granted by the Programme Committee. under exceptional circumstances.
