BUIRC2014 Proposal submission and presentation guideline:**Panel discussions**

Presentation time:	2 hour
Submission length:	2-6 pages
Equipment provided:	Laptop, LCD Projector and Internet

Each Panel consisting of 3-5 people (including the chair), present their views on a common theme/ issue/ question, and allow discusses with the audience. Selection of the panel based on importance and timeliness of the topic. Discussion should be informative on either ways. Panels must allot at least 50% of the time for interaction and discussion with the audience.

Paper presentations

Presentation time:	40 minutes
Submission guideline:	8 pages minimum, 12 pages maximum
Equipment provided:	Laptop, LCD Projector and Internet

These presentations report significant work, research, development and application related to conference topics/theme.

Lightening presentations – Small paper, Best practice and Research presentations

Presentation time: 20 minutes
Submission guideline: 4 pages minimum, 6 pages maximum
Equipment provided: Laptop, LCD Projector and Internet

These are more condensed presentations. Presenters are allowed to discuss their own research works, experiences and contemporary perspectives related to the conference theme.

This format will allow the presenter to present their work with 30 slides that advance automatically every 30 seconds.

Roundtable discussions

Presentation time: 1 hour
Submission length: 2-6 pages
Equipment provided: none

These sessions allow maximum interaction in informal and small-group discussions on a single topic.

Workshops

Presentation time: 2 -3hours
Submission length: Clear description of the objectives
Intended audience (experience level and prerequisites)
Proposed length (Maximum 3 hours)
1-page topical outline of the content
Summary of the facilitator qualifications and experience
Equipment provided: Laptop, LCD Projector and Internet

Workshops are intended to enhance the skills and broaden contemporary perspective of e-Learning. These workshops aimed to introduce rigorous frameworks for e-learning or to provide advanced knowledge on conference topics/theme. Submissions will be selected on the basis of the facilitator qualifications and experiences in the overall conference program.

Research/Technical/product showcases

Presentation time: Throughout the conference days
Submission length: 2-6 pages
Equipment provided: Poster board, 1table, 2 chairs, Laptop, LCD Projector and Internet



Research/Technical/product showcases enable researchers and developers to demonstrate and discuss their latest results and developments in e-Learning / e-Learning technologies.

Virtual presentations

Presentation time:

40 minutes

Submission proposal length:

4 pages minimum, 6 pages maximum

Equipment provided:

Laptop, LCD Projector, and Internet

Virtual sessions enable researchers to present and asynchronously discuss their research via Skype/online discussion tools. These papers are brief or extensions to existing projects.
