- 1. A candidate must have <u>one</u> of the two following main requirements :
 - 1.1 Candidates must hold a Bachelor's degree in any discipline with 1st class honor or,
 - 1.2 Candidates must hold a Master's degree in any discipline with grade point average of 3.50
- 2. Submit 3 copies evidence of scholarly or professional attainments and show satisfactory research preparation to the Programme Committee;
- 3. Submit a certificate of English proficiency with minimum admission score:
 - IELTS at least 3 or
 - TOEFL INTERNET BASED at least 32 or
 - TOEFL ITP (test arranged by Faculty of Graduate Study, Mahidol University) at least 400

Important Notes:

- English proficiency score must be taken within 2 years up to the admission date.
- Application without submitting a valid English certificate will NOT be considered.

- 4. Exemption from the above conditions may be granted by the Programme Committee under exceptional circumstances.

Registration

- 1. Students must register as full-time students.
- 2. The Programme Committee may recommend students take up to 9 credits of course-work in any subject offered by the Faculty of Environment and Resource Studies or other departments in Mahidol University without credit and the student has to attend at least 80% of the classes.
- 3. The Programme Committee will require students to present at least one paper per year in an academic conference or a public forum on an aspect of their research.
- 4. At the end of each academic semester students will provide a detailed report to the Supervisory Panel on the progress made during that semester, the progress expected to be made in the upcoming year, and details of any problems associated with the research which have arisen or may arise. After reviewing the student progress, the Supervisory Panel will forward the report, with their own comments, to the Programme Committee which will confirm, suspend, or terminate the student's enrollment.

Written Examination

There is NO written examination for this program. Applicants must check their eligibility for interview upon the announcing date of the interview list which is scheduled for each admission round.
